

## GARBAGE AND TRASH PICKUP FOR HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 501

**IF YOU HAVE A TRASH ISSUE**, call **(866) 516-9805** to report the issue.  
Complaints are monitored by the MUD 501 Board.

**Trash service days are Tuesday and Friday and trash is defined as waste generated inside the home. Trash must be placed at the garage door (visible from the street and accessible) or at the curb by 7:00 a.m. If your trash is not placed at one of these locations and is not accessible, it will not be picked up.** No trash shall be placed at curb for collection except on the designated trash days. Up to six (6) cans/bags of properly contained household waste, each weighing less than 40 pounds will be accepted for weekly pickup.

**Recycling service day is every Tuesday. The recycling containers must be placed at the garage door (visible from the street and accessible) or at the curb by 7:00 a.m. If your recycling is not placed at one of these locations and is not accessible, it will not be picked up.** Recycling items should be placed in the 48-gallon cart provided by RRRTx. The recycling items that are acceptable are glass, plastics 1-7, thin plastic, paper, cardboard, tin/aluminum cans. No sorting of different types of recycling items is required, but RRRTx prefers, although does not require, that recycling items be placed in clear, white, or light blue bags before they are placed in the cart. RRRTx will not collect recycling items that are placed in black bags.

**Yard waste service days are Tuesday and Friday. Yard waste must be placed at the curb to be picked up.** Yard waste includes leaves, grass clippings and vegetative matter. It must be placed in sturdy plastic bags weighing less than 40 lb. All branches and tree trimming have to be smaller than 3 inches in diameter and must not exceed 4 feet in length and they must be securely tied in bundles that weighing less then 40lb.

**Bulk items service day is Friday. Bulk items must be placed at the curb to be picked up.** Bulk items are defined as small pieces of furniture, washers, dryers, water heaters and stoves. **Any CFC (Freon) item must be properly tagged by a certified technician that all Freon has been properly removed in accordance with the Federal Clean Air Act regulations. If items are not tagged, they will not be picked up.** This service allows for only one item per household per week
