

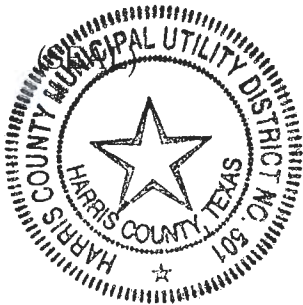
## NOTICE OF MEETING

### HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 501

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 501 will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, November 7, 2018, at 5:30 p.m.**, at **The Lakehouse, 10000 Towne Lake Parkway, Cypress, Texas**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Receive public comments.\*
2. Approve minutes.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, and Section 44 Supplemental Developer Reimbursement Report.
4. Conduct annual review of Investment Policy and adopt Resolution Regarding Annual Review of Investment Policy.
5. Review, revise, and adopt Resolution Establishing the Authorized Depository Institutions and Adopting List of Qualified Broker/Dealers with Whom the District May Engage in Investment Transactions.
6. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
7. Conduct public hearing regarding District's tax rate, adopt Order Levying Taxes, and authorize execution of Amendment to Information Form.
8. Discuss garbage collection and recycling matters, including fall community shred event and report from Trash Committee.
9. Website matters.
10. Operation of District facilities, billings and convenience fees, repairs and maintenance.
11. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
12. Review proposal from Vepo, LLC for W.I.S.E. Guys residential irrigation audits and authorize appropriate action, if necessary.
13. Engineering matters, including report on grade separation at Union Pacific Railroad and intersection improvements at Highway 290.
14. Approve Submerged Storm Sewer Agreements.
15. Approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, and review bids and award construction contracts;
16. Approve pay estimates and change orders, including for the following projects:
  - a. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Towne Lake, Section 39, Replat 1; and
  - b. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Towne Lake, Section 41.

17. Water, sewer, and drainage facilities and paving repairs in Towne Lake, Sections 27 and 28.
18. Requests for capacity reservation to Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 500 (Master) and requests for utility commitments.
19. Approve contract with Storm Water Solutions, L.P.
20. Accept or grant conveyance of deeds, utility deeds, and easements and approve consents to encroachment, encroachment agreements, rights of entry, abandonment of easement, and environmental proposals.
21. West Harris County Regional Water Authority matters.
22. Report regarding development in the District, including acquisition of new tract within the District.
23. Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 500 (Master) matters, including:
  - a. discuss Master District recreational and detention facilities; and
  - b. discuss lake erosion/maintenance, including report from Lake Erosion/Maintenance Committee.
24. Community education matters, including report from Community Education Committee.
25. Security matters, including report from Security Committee.
26. Report from District consultants regarding District correspondence and provision of records.
27. Discuss utility rates, and amend Rate Order.
28. Discuss meeting schedule, including addition of future agenda items, and discuss purchase of name plates.
29. Convene in Executive Session to conduct a private consultation with attorney to discuss pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer, pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code.
30. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action.
